Accommodations:

Interns live in our intern village which includes a kitchen/living area, male/female dormitories, and shower house with other interns/stewards. Bedroom is shared and bathroom is shared. Lodging is simple, with basic amenities (heat, indoor bathroom). Amenities:

Electric or gas heat, Solar heat, TV, VCR/DVD, Computer & Internet for steward use, Free&daily internet on-site, Telephone (Free local calls only; must buy own calling card for non-local calls), Bicycle for excursions to nearby shops/town/public transit (less than 3 miles one-way), Food provided by host to cook your own meals(shared with other interns.)Free, seasonal farm products.(Example: fruits and vegetables)
